**Alternative Schools**

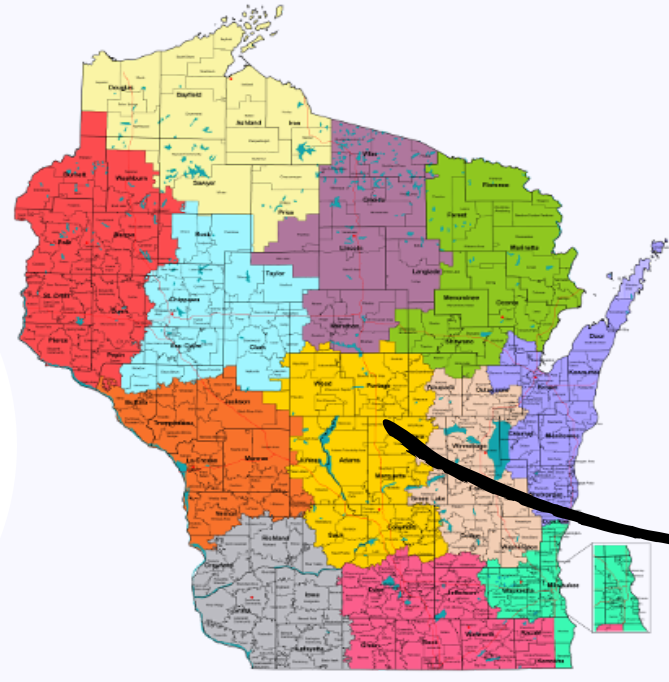
CESA 5 operates alternative schools with a focus on behavior and reintegration skills which enable students to be successful in their local school districts.

**Classrooms for Students with Specific Needs**

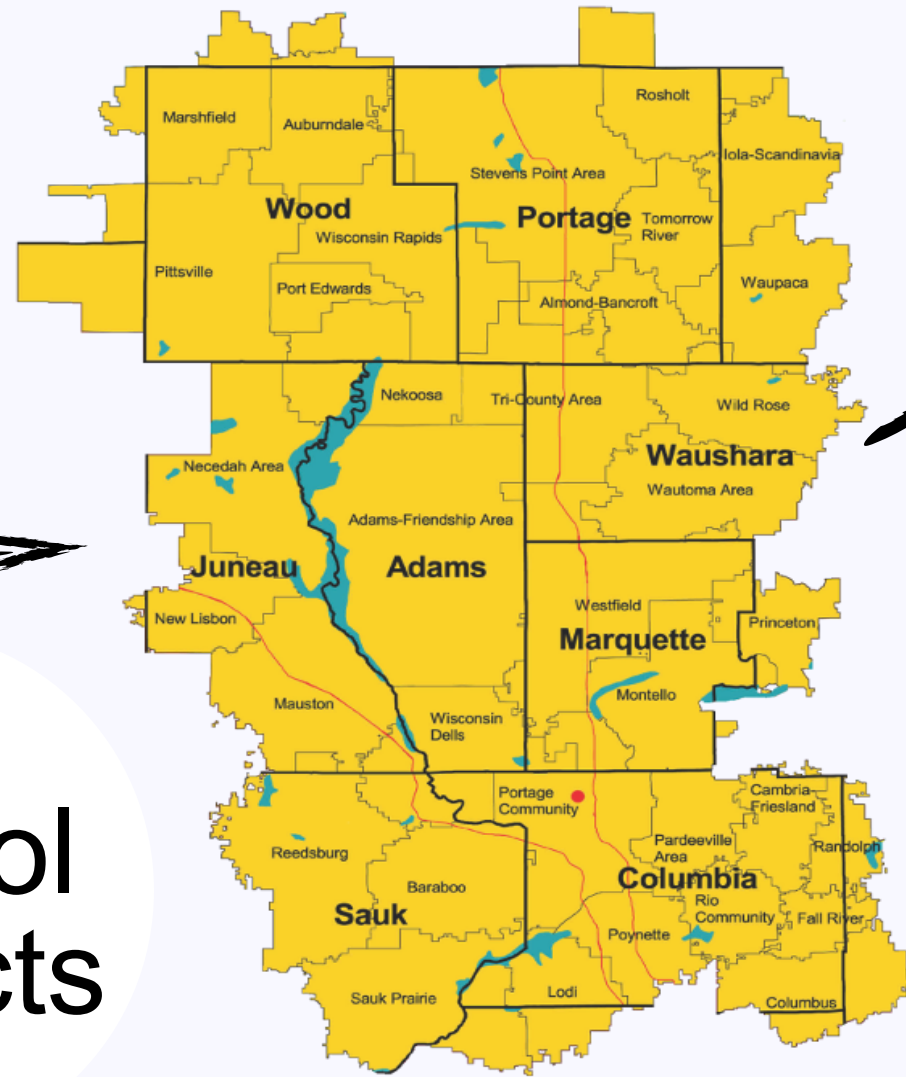
CESA 5 operates classrooms within schools for students with specific needs such as vision impairment and intellectual disabilities.
