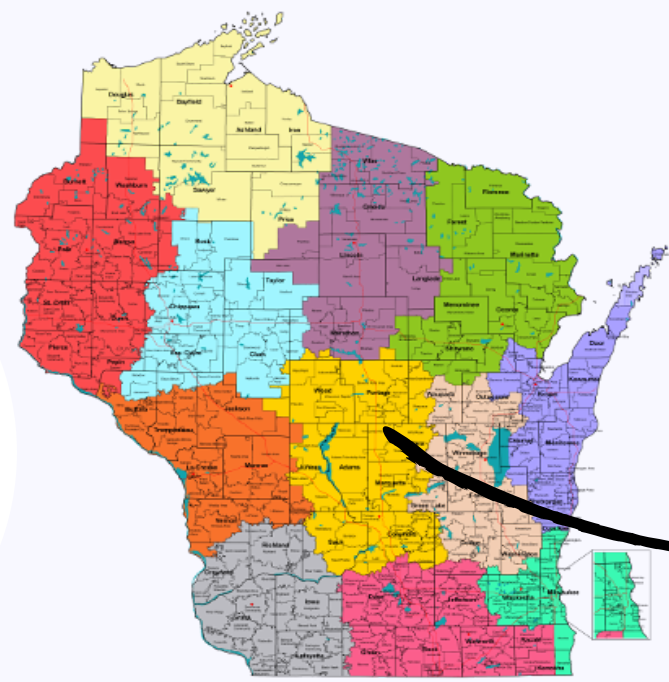
Alternative Schools

Classrooms for Students with Specific Needs

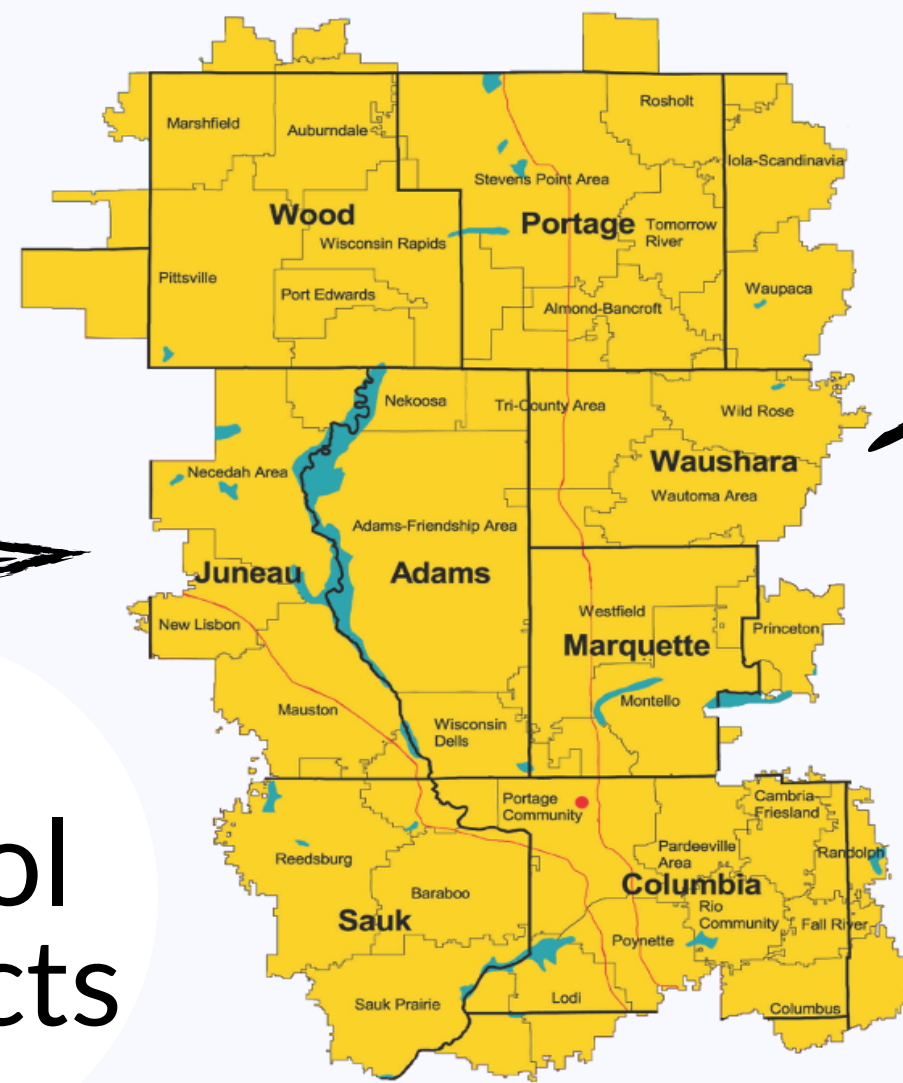
