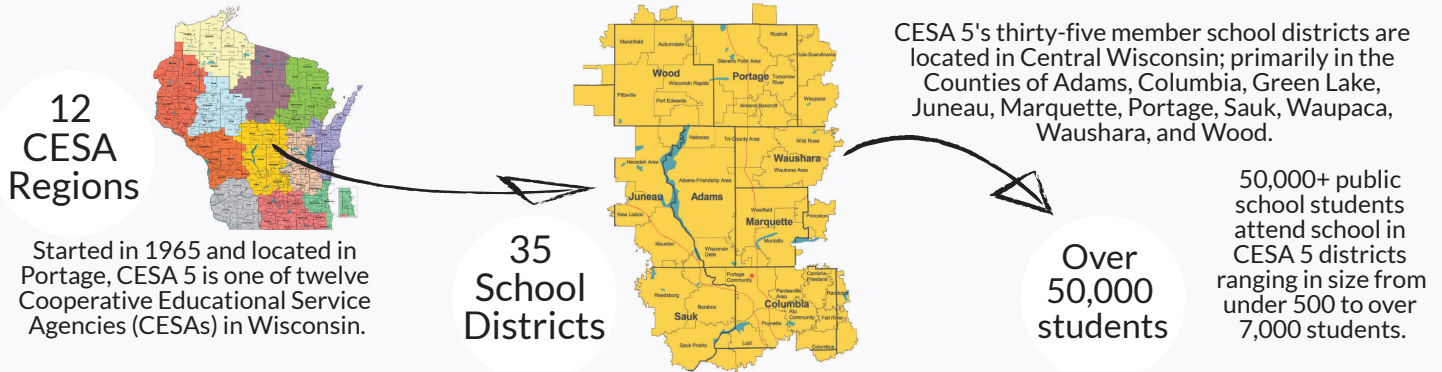
Behavioral support, mentoring, nursing, professional development, program audits, and secretarial staffing.
