LEVEL 1: TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT SPECIALIST

The technology support specialists maintain the general operations of computer devices and related software, hardware, or network connections.

- Located on-site during the school week
- Primary contact for all technology related issues
- Provides technical assistance to district staff as necessary; in-person or remotely
- Sets up new computer systems and perform routine maintenance
- Ensures operational internet security software
- Maintains & repairs computer equipment and software to ensure secure and efficient operations
- Tests and implements new software programs for the organization

LEVEL 2: NETWORK SPECIALIST

The Network Specialist manages the networks to ensure they function efficiently.

- Available for troubleshooting via remote access during the school week and/or on-site as needed
- Monitors and troubleshoots network security and system functionality
- Collects network performance data
- Performs routine maintenance and proactively addresses potential problems
- Evaluates network data to ensure consistently adequate speed and space
- Provides recommendations for future needs
- Provides support to technology support specialist

LEVEL 3: TECHNOLOGY DIRECTOR

Establishes, plans, and administers the overall policies and goals for the information technology department.

- Support E-Rate and Infrastructure grants
- Manages the helpdesk and project management systems
- Provides oversight of CESA 5 technology staff and communicates with school district administration
- Researches and implements strategic solutions
 with approval of the school district
