CESA 5 Hearing Services include:

- Educational Audiologists
- Educational Interpreters
- Teachers of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing (DHH)

Contracted Services SP04, SP05, SP06

Educational Audiologists

- Gather information and data about student access to verbal instruction
- Determine accommodations, modifications, and hearing assistive technology that may be needed in order to make school accessible to students
- Coach the adults working with students on how to implement these supports

DHH Teachers

- Instruct and support students who are deaf or hard of hearing in their chosen mode of communication
- Assess a student's needs
- Support academic and functional goals
- Can provide in-service training and/or consultation to school personnel
- Consult with the student's family and teachers on the best strategies for working with the student

Educational Interpreters

- Facilitate communication between students who are deaf or hard of hearing and their hearing peers, teachers, and other school staff
