

CESA 5 Physical Therapists (PT) and Physical Therapy Assistants (PTA) provide consultation and direct services to students as determined by IEP teams.

Addressing Student Concerns

- Physical Therapists address concerns in the motor and adaptive behavior domains including:
 - Gross motor
 - Mobility
 - Play/leisure skills
 - Positioning

Utilizing Strategies

- Physical Therapists provide embedded intervention strategies to students as well as collaborate with and coach:
 - Other team members
 - Parents
 - School personnel

Interventions

- Physical Therapists design interventions that improve a student's physical ability to access their educational environments:
 - Classroom
 - Hallways
 - Lunch
 - Recess
 - Restroom
 - Worksites

Equipment

 Working as a member of the IEP team, a Physical Therapist may suggest equipment to address a student's access and/or participation concerns
